BIBLE STORY:

Matthew 4:18-22; 10:1-4; Mark 1:16-20
Mark 3:13-19 Luke 5: 1-11

MEMORY VERSE:

Mark 1:17

BIBLE STORY:

The Good Samaritan

Luke 10:25-37

MEMORY VERSE:

Luke 10:27

“You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind and your neighbor as yourself.”

HOME DISCUSSION:

There was a man walking on the road and robbers came by to hurt him. He lay bleeding on the road. Two people passed by, a Priest and a Levite, and neither of them helped the hurt man. They just looked at him and walked on the other side of the road. A third man, called a Samaritan, saw the hurt man on the road. He stopped to put bandages on the wounds and took him to an inn so he could get better. The Samaritan even paid money to the inn keeper to take care of him until he was better. Jesus said we are to act like this Samaritan; treat all people as your neighbor by being helpful and loving to them.
