## BIBLE STORY:

### The Last Supper

Matthew 26:17-29 & Mark 14:12-25 &

## MEMORY VERSE:

Luke 22:19 And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me." Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you."

## HOME DISCUSSION:

Jesus and his disciples partook in the custom of the Passover Feast. This dinner reminds them of how God provided for their needs as they were escaping out of Egypt to go to the Promised Land. ### Palm Sunday

Matthew 21:1-11 & Mark 11: 1-11 &  
Luke 19:28-40 & John 12:12-19

## MEMORY VERSE:

Hebrew 10:5
