

## 2021 High School Boy's Camping Trip

This event is for high school boys. There will be 16 open spots for students. **Before securing a spot we must have a copy of the student's insurance card, a complete and signed waiver and payment in full, which will be non-refundable.** We will be swimming, hiking, doing team building challenges, and camping. This trip can be unpredictable and dangerous. Each kid must be able to swim or bring a lifejacket.

### Important Dates/Times:

- Tuesday 7/22, 6:00pm-9:00pm DROP OFF your PACKED backpack to Pastor Billy at the church.
- Wednesday 7/28 leave at 10:00pm, after service, from the church
- Saturday 7/31 return to the church by 9:00pm

Price: \$95 – includes transportation, tents, park permit and food while camping, transportation and gas but does not include food while on the road. We will need to stop on the way up and on the way back for gas etc. at which time we will get food as well.

### **PACK ALL THESE THINGS IN A BACK PACK AND DROP OFF TO PASTOR BILLY**

**Tuesday 7/22, BETWEEN 6-9 PM (Please put your name on everything you pack):**

- Sleeping bag or fleece blanket
- Hiking boots or sturdy gym shoes. These shoes will get very dirty.
- Additional pair of shoes preferably athletic that can get and stay wet (for being in the water with)
  - Unless you only want to bring one. But keep in mind we will be in the water and you will have to have shoes on for that.
- 2 outfits, both that can be used to sleep in, swim in AND hike in
  - All clothes should be light weight and dry quickly
    - Nylon, polyester type (athletic) materials work best
    - **No cotton or denim**
    - Avg. temp during day is in the 70's and at night the mid 60's
  - One warm outfit to sleep in only and be kept dry.
  - 1 light fleece top. A light fleece jacket is good
  - 2 pair of socks wool or synthetic are best, if you have them
  - 2 pair of underwear (non-cotton)
  - Flip flops.
- Bug Spray and/or bug net. There will be lots of bugs.
- One clean outfit to leave in the vehicle to travel home in.
- Tooth brush and tooth paste
- Any personal medications
  - Please only bring the prescribed amount for the time we will be gone and no more.
- Small flashlight or headlamp
- A non-breakable cup (12-16oz preferably) and a spoon.
- Water bottle (32oz)
- **WE ASK THAT THERE BE NO PHONES AT ALL ON THIS TRIP. LEADERS WILL HAVE THEIRS IN THE EVENT WE NEED TO BE IN TOUCH. You can feel free to call Pastor Billy at any point – 248.534.5821**
- Personal food and snacks OR money (\$20 is ok) for the car rides to and from. This food will stay in the bus while we are camping. You can just bring this with you the day we leave.
